

## Take Dominion

### A summary of what we have learned so far:

- God's Kingdom was brought in by the Messiah during the Roman Empire (Book of Daniel, John the Baptist – the Kingdom of God is at hand)
- That which is physical first then that which is spiritual (apostle Paul)
- We have already come to the end of the age of the old covenant and have entered into the Messianic era (by definition the Messiah has come)
- It is a spiritual Kingdom which has new everything. New King, new laws, new subjects, new city (the New Jerusalem) etc...
- We have become sons/daughters, kings and priests of The King
- The Kingdom of God established in the new covenant era must be far superior to anything established under the old covenant
- Under this new jurisdiction – we are no longer under the law (Romans) we operate under the law of love and liberty in Christ Jesus
- God has changed the rules on our behalf, he has created all things to be new hence the phrase “I create a new heavens and a new earth”
- He has given us authority – in fact all authority has been given unto Jesus our new King and he has given us this authority
- The Kingdom of God is expanding like yeast causing dough to expand
- The knowledge of God will fill the whole Earth (Hosea)
  
- Satan has lost his authority in Heaven
- We are to take dominion of this Earth ([For the creation waits with eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed. Romans 8:9](#)). A restoration to the situation in the garden of Eden.
- The mandate and inheritance is clear in Isaiah 62 (The Messiah starts the process on Earth)

## Isaiah 61

**Is. 61:1** The Spirit of the Lord Yahweh is on me; because Yahweh has anointed me to preach good news to the humble; he has sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening *of the prison* to those who are bound; **2** to proclaim the year of Yahweh's favor, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; **3** to appoint to those who mourn in Zion, to give to them a garland for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of Yahweh, that he may be glorified.

**4** They shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations. **5** Strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and foreigners shall be your plowmen and your vine-dressers. **6** But you shall be named the priests of Yahweh; men shall call you the ministers of our God: you shall eat the wealth of the nations, and in their glory shall you boast yourselves. **7** Instead of your shame *you shall have double*; and instead of dishonor they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess double; everlasting joy shall be to them. **8** For I, Yahweh, love justice, I hate robbery with iniquity; and I will give them their recompense in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. **9** Their seed shall be known among the nations, and their offspring among the peoples; all who see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which Yahweh has blessed. **10** I will greatly rejoice in Yahweh, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. **11** For as the earth brings forth its bud, and as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so the Lord Yahweh will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.

## Solomon's Kingdom

**1Kings 5:1** Hiram king of Tyre sent his servants to Solomon; for he had heard that they had anointed him king in the room of his father: for Hiram was ever a lover of David. <sup>2</sup> Solomon sent to Hiram, saying, <sup>3</sup> You know how that David my father could not build a house for the name of Yahweh his God for the wars which were about him on every side, **until Yahweh put them under the soles of his feet.** <sup>4</sup> **But now Yahweh my God has given me rest on every side; there is neither adversary, nor evil occurrence.**

#### Joshua 1

<sup>3</sup> Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread on, to you have I given it, as I spoke to Moses. <sup>4</sup> From the wilderness, and this Lebanon, even to the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your border. <sup>5</sup> There shall not any man be able to stand before you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will not fail you, nor forsake you. <sup>6</sup> Be strong and of good courage; for you shall cause this people to inherit the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. <sup>7</sup> Only be strong and very courageous, to observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded you: don't turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. <sup>8</sup> This book of the law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate thereon day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall have good success.

#### Malachi 4

<sup>2</sup> But to you who fear my name shall the sun of righteousness arise with healing in its wings. You will go out, and leap like calves of the stall. <sup>3</sup> You shall tread down the wicked; for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I make," says Yahweh of Hosts.

## Ephesians 1

<sup>22</sup> He put all things in subjection under his feet, and gave him to be head over all things for the assembly, <sup>23</sup> which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all.

## 1 Corinthians

<sup>25</sup> For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.

**Luke 10:18** He said to them, “I saw Satan having fallen like lightning from heaven. <sup>19</sup> Behold, I give you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy. Nothing will in any way hurt you. <sup>20</sup> Nevertheless, don’t rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”

**Rev. 12:7** There was war in the sky. Michael and his angels made war on the dragon. The dragon and his angels made war. <sup>8</sup> They didn't prevail, neither was a place found for him any more in heaven. <sup>9</sup> The great dragon was thrown down, the old serpent, he who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world. He was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. <sup>10</sup> I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now is come the salvation, the power, and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ; for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them before our God day and night.
